
Ashraya

Ashraya, the centre which got inaugurated with the purpose of serving society. Here we have obtained students from 3 major sections.


- 1. Kids of daily wage worker, who stays in Jhuggi
 - Kids with the prior school facilities in a native village.
 - 1st a time learner.
- 2. Kids of daily wage workers (a bit of stability, like a maid, zomato delivery boy etc.)
 - Students who have shifted recently that's why they couldn't get admission to schools, so coming to us to keep their learning going smoothly.
 - Students who go to government schools.
- 3. Kids from a lower middle-class family
 - Parents try their level hard to provide quality education to kids despite earning very less, but kids don't get quality education in those schools, coming to us as their tuition class.
 - Those who don't go to school at all.
- 4. Kids who were begging.



Challenges

It was a bit tough to make the kids from jhuggi keep coming to the centre, although we have to go searching for them to bring them back to the class for studies.

Some of these kids were addicted to 'nasha', 'jua' and had bad habits, it was very tough for them to focus and sit silently in the class, we made the class in a happening way that they could learn while playing itself.




Result

- We have gotten students from good family backgrounds, they help our kids learn to dance and in back, we deliver them the best.
- Our neighbour Hotel Elite Peak is very supportive and sends our kids sweets and cakes occasionally. We have gotten their guests as our visitors quite often.
- These kids are getting to be known as Ashraya students and not as bad kids.

Activities

- Every Sunday we have our dance class.
- We have our art & craft sessions every Sunday evening.
- Our kids learn gardening as well, and they have helped look our garden very pretty.
- We perform drama occasionally.

- Students performed dance.
- We had a fancy dress show.
- Poem recitation.

We performed Hawan and distributed notebooks and pens.

Extra Activities

1. Gardening

- We have decorated the Entrance of the centre with planting many flowers, which make the centre look so beautiful and children feel happy to see it all.
- Parents visit and appreciate the beauty and serenity of the garden.
- Make good impressions for our centre on the guests of neighbour Hotel.

2. Backyard Cleaning

We have made the backyard look clean and pretty, helping us to get rid of wild creatures.

3. Home Visits
