INTRODUCTION





Our Vision is for all of us to realise that each individual should care for society. Our work and events are open for all those who are passionate about creating a better, more empathetic society.







GREEN INITIATIVES -ENVIRONMENT



iCFDR with RWA of K block, Palam Vihar, Gurgaon to set up a waste management plant in order to inculcate on site segregation and recycling practices in the block and also to beautify the surroundings with horticultural and plantation activity. We plan to further beautify the neighborhood and turn it more green as it will foster cleanliness.





We are also hoping to segregate and process most of our waste on-site so that the bare minimum is sent to the landfills. A crucial partner of the project is Aakaar Iron Creations Private Limited who are funding the initiative under CSR.








Setting up the waste recycling centre in the K block, Palam Vihar, Gurgaon and inculcating good waste management practices such as waste segregation and composting, was at the very centre of this project







The project also led to enhancing the beauty of the block by planting various seasonal as well as permanent ornamental flowering plants and trees. The tube well in the fountain park was also repaired so that adequate water is available for all 9 parks







IMPACT OF THE PROJECT:

- There is a direct positive impact on the cleanliness of the block.
- The waste management initiatives help us practice recycling, and protect the environment.
- The plantation will ensure a green cover and clean, breathable air throughout the block.
