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





JAN KALYAN KENDRAS (JKKs)





ICFDR (Indian Centre for Development and Rights), in collaboration with Cograd Schools, established three Jan Kalyan Kendras (JKKs) in Etawah, Uttar Pradesh. This initiative aims to provide hassle-free access to all government schemes (both central and state) for the people. The main objective of the JKKs is to offer last-mile digital services to individuals in rural India.

Ranjit Singh Public School: Tulsipur, the nearest village to Ranjit Singh Public School (JKK), relies primarily on agriculture and dairy products. The JKK at this location has made the villagers aware of various government programs and schemes. It also provides students with facilities to fill out forms for competitive exams, gather information on colleges and universities, and access government scholarships.

St. Maria School: Udi is the closest village to St. Maria School, where most families are truck drivers. Since the JKK was established, more people have started visiting to obtain information. This center offers free computer education, benefiting the youth from nearby schools and colleges.

Vaidya H.N. Singh Public School: Nagla Sikarwar is the nearest village to Vaidya H.N. Singh Public School, with Ghiror as the closest town, known for its large garlic market. The JKK here provides farmers with valuable information for their agricultural practices.

Many people have utilized the facilities at these Jan Kalyan Kendras, gaining necessary information for various purposes. The JKKs are dedicated to offering a wide range of essential services to the community, including PAN card applications, electricity bill payments, new electric connections, Jawahar Navodaya entrance registrations, Colgate Foundation scholarships, Kisan Samman Nidhi, and insurance services.

Additionally, the JKKs provide e-nagrik and e-district services for obtaining birth and death certificates, pension services, NIOS registration, NIELIT services, Aadhar printing and enrollment, PAN card services, electoral services, e-courts and results services, state electricity and water bill collections, and Department of Post services. Through these diverse facilities, JKK aims to simplify administrative processes, enhance access to essential services, and contribute to the community's welfare.
